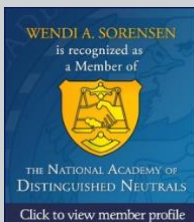

FEE SCHEDULE

Mediation services provided at \$600.00 per hour, which includes:

- Time spent at the mediation
- Preparation for the mediation
- Preparation of documents after the mediation
- Discussions and telephone conferences with all parties involved, before, during, or after the mediation

The following minimum charges apply:

- A minimum of 2 hours for half-day
- A minimum of 6 hours for full-day
- Additional time may be charged for any necessary preparation

The fee is to be split evenly between the parties

CANCELLATION POLICY

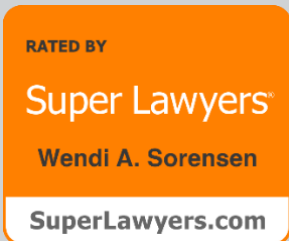
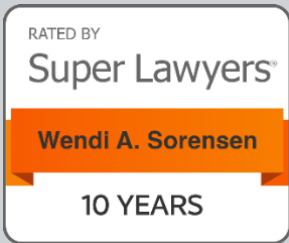
For cancellations made within seven days or less of the scheduled mediation, a minimum fee of \$1500 for half day or \$3000 for a full day mediation will be charged to the party responsible for the cancellation. If both parties agree to the cancellation, the fee will be divided equally between them
